## Home Health Care

Keokuk Area Hospital Home Health Care has Registered Nurses, Therapists and Certified Nurse Aides who can assist you or your loved one in the comfort of your own home.

Following a hospitalization, an episode of acute illness or whenever there are health care issues that need to be addressed at home, KAH Home Health Care has someone who can come to your home to help you deal with your medical or personal care problems.

### Home Health Care is ideal for:

- Discharged hospital or nursing home patients needing follow-up care.
- Patients with diabetes, muscle-nerve disorders, and heart, kidney or respiratory disease.
- Incapacitated maternity or same-day surgery patients needing short-term assistance.
- Terminally ill patients who choose to remain at home.
- Teaching and assistance with wound, catheter and ostomy care.
- Individuals requiring personal care assistance or homemaker/chore services.

### Available Services

The following may be paid for by a variety of sources, including: Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance, waivers, Veteran's Administration, workman's compensation or the individual's or family's own resources.

**Medical Care** – Provided by Registered Nurses. All types of care available, including: telemonitoring, wound care, urinary catheter care, feeding tubes, administration of IV medications or fluids, diabetic teaching, ostomy care, medication management and assessment of unstable conditions.

**Psychiatric Care** – Provided by a Registered Nurse experienced in Psychiatric Care. Specialized services include psychiatric assessment/monitoring of client status, medication management and administration of injectable psychotropic medications.

**Personal Care/Homemaking** – Provided by Certified Nurse Aides. Assistance with walking and grooming, bathing, dressing and nail care; shopping, simple meal preparation, light housekeeping and laundry.

**Rehabilitation** – Provided by Professional Therapists. Physical, Speech or Occupational Therapy to recover from illness or injury.

**Medical Social Services** – Provided by a Social Worker. Evaluation of financial needs and assistance in obtaining local support services; counsel and assure emotional needs of the individual and the family are met.

**Respite** – For waiver eligible individuals. Helps assure safety, companionship and activities of daily living; light housekeeping, laundry, shopping and simple meal preparation.
